

Stone Pillar Vineyard and Winery is situated atop a gently sloping hill on property that has been in the Hoff family for five generations, predating the Civil War. Their farmstead is the oldest continuously-operated family farm in the state of Kansas. The Hoff's welcome you to visit during regular hours or at one of their many after-hours special events.

Stone Pillar Vineyard and Winery was started in 2007 by George, Frank, and Tommy Hoff. During a vacation to Niagara Falls, George was awestruck by the beauty of the vines. After tasting the delectable wines of Niagara, he fell in love with the idea of creating a vineyard on the family's farmstead in Olathe. After much research and planning, the family started its first planting in 2007 and they continue to develop their operation today. Officially, Stone Pillar Vineyard and Winery opened its doors to the public on May 1, 2010.

Stone Pillar Vineyard and Winery offers a wide array of award-winning varietal wines, from sweet to dry in both red and white styles. Known for their blends, Stone Pillar's wines also have been recognized at many prestigious competitions, including the following designations: Prairie Star Blush won gold medals at the Jefferson Cup, the Mid-American Wine Competition, and the Monterey Wine Competition. Joceaux – pronounced Joco – won a platinum medal at the Monterey Wine Competition, as well as silver medals at the Mid-American, Jefferson Cup, Finger Lakes International, and the Florida State Fair. Hofftoberfest won gold awards at Cold Climate International and the Jefferson Cup, in addition to several other awards.



- Relive the adventures of early stagecoach passengers traveling the Santa Fe Trail on the Barlow and Sanderson Stagecoach Line. The stone farmhouse built by J.B. and Lucinda Mahaffie in 1865 was one of the first stops for westbound travelers using the Westport Route of the Santa Fe, California, and Oregon Trails. Listed on the National Register of Places and recognized as a certified site on the Santa Fe National Historic Trail by the National Park Service, Mahaffie is the only original stagecoach stop on the Santa Fe Trail that is open to the public.
- Tour the Mahaffie home, which features a full basement that served as the stagecoach dining hall and kitchen.





- See the original Mahaffie timber-frame barn and a unique, two-story stone ice house. Enjoy the working blacksmith shop, special programs, gift shop, and ride on a real stagecoach.
- The recently opened Heritage Center features the exhibit "...I knew it was a fine country..." which tells the stories of the Mahaffie family, the city of Olathe in the 1860s, and life on the western trails. It also features a gift shop and other visitor amenities. The Olathe Historical Society presents rotating exhibits on various stories in Olathe history in an adjoining gallery.
- Open year-round. Living history activities, programs, and hours vary by season. Go to Mahaffie.org or call for admission hours and programs.






