## Gavin Park

- Nine soccer and multi-use fields
- Six baseball and softball fields
- Two multi-purpose gymnasiums
- Outdoor tennis courts
- Meeting rooms, game room and playground
- Walking paths and track
- Batting cage and indoor/outdoor batting machine
- Pavilions and concession area

## Clifton Common

- 6 regulation soccer fields, including 1 premier field
- 3 half sized soccer fields
- 2 NHL regulation ice rinks
- 6 softball fields, including 1 premier field
- 8 baseball fields, including 1 Babe Ruth Field
- 4 outdoor basketball courts

## Saratoga Polo Association Fields

- 2 full sized polo fields, 300 by 160 yards each

## Saratoga Spa State Park

- 2,500 acre state park
- 18 miles of paved roads and nature trails ideal for biking and running sports
- Cross country skiing and snowshoeing trails
- Hotel, golf courses, museums, tennis courts, pools, pavilions, natural mineral springs and more on-site
- Regular host of all levels of running and biking events

## Saratoga Lake

- Host to several local, regional and national regattas each year
- Regular host to summer water sports and winter ice sports
- New York State boat launch, docks, event space and abundant parking on site
- 4,000+ acres, average depth of 25 feet
- 4.5 miles long, 1.5 miles wide

## Saratoga Springs Recreational Center

- A 33,500 square foot facility with 26,000 square feet of court space
- Four United States junior high school-size basketball courts, two collegiate size courts, two large tournament style volleyball courts and four smaller volleyball courts
- Features a Racquetball court, that can be converted into a Squash or "Wally-Ball" court
- Additional wall protection has been installed to accommodate indoor soccer and lacrosse
- Features game room with a pool table and video games

- Seating for 500

- Olympic Size Rink
- Seating for 1500
