Vibrant Arena at The MARK Moline, IL

Sports: Multi-use, basketball, football (indoor), wrestling, hockey, rodeo, ice skating

This 31,000+ square-foot arena seats over 11,000 and features ample parking, four locker rooms, six production offices, and a conference center. It includes a regulation court, full-size hockey and figure skating rink, skyboxes, video scoreboards with replay, and a PA system. An additional 12,500 square feet of meeting space with 16-foot ceilings is also available.

Events Hosted: Missouri Valley Conference Women's Basketball Championships, University of Iowa Men's Basketball Regular Season Games, home to Quad City Steamwheelers arena football and Quad City Storm hockey games.

Modern Woodmen Park Davenport, IA

This Class "A" facility, home to the Quad Cities River Bandits (Kansas City Royals affiliate), features seating for 4,000+, evening lighting, electronic scoreboards, team locker rooms, a press box, 20 suites, a lounge, a bar, and concessions. 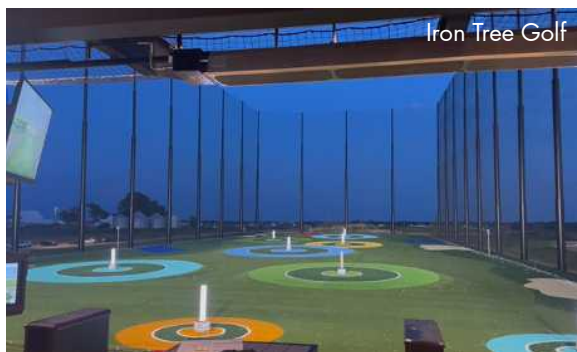

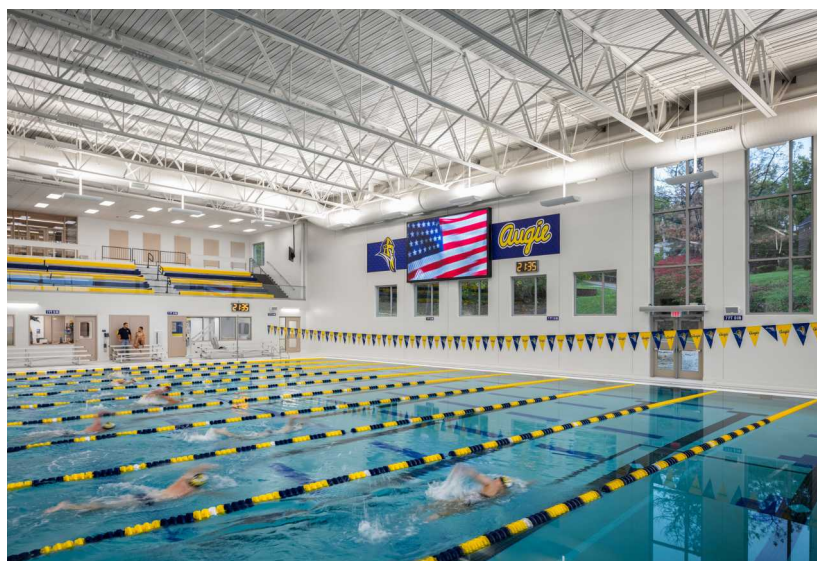

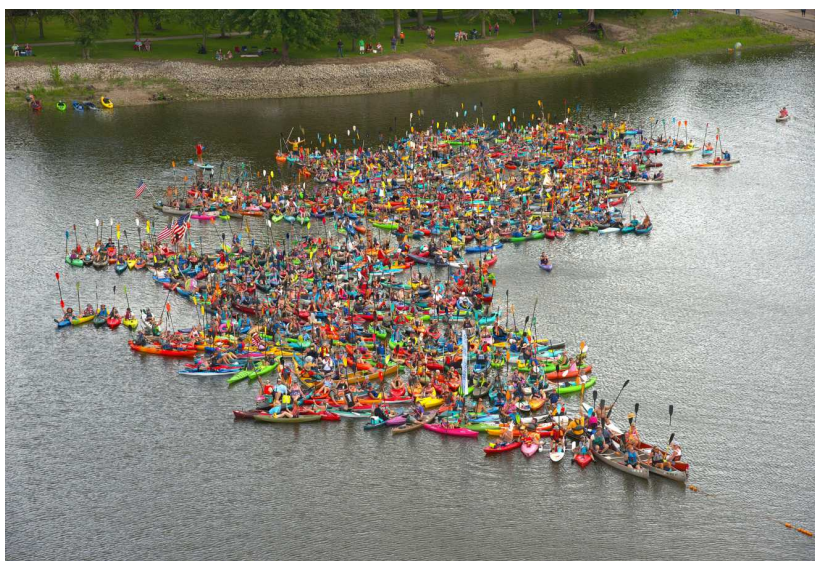

Esports in the Quad Cities

The Quad Cities is rapidly becoming a regional hub for esports, hosting major events like the NECC Hometown Series, Big Ten Esports Championship, and grassroots tournaments such as Paradigm Shift, Goals & Gambits, and Honeypot, the largest esports tournament in Iowa. With thriving high school, college, and community programs, the QC speaks the language of competitive gaming.

Top Venues: Rhythm City Casino Resort, Putnam Museum, Vibrant Arena at THE MARK, Waterfront Convention Center, RiverCenter, TBK Bank Sports Complex, Augustana College, St. Ambrose University, Mississippi Valley Fairgrounds, Bend XPO.

Augustana College Esports

Launched in 2022 as the college's 29th varsity sport, Augustana Esports is its first all-gender athletic team. The Viking Esports Center includes 20 PC stations, next-gen consoles, a broadcast studio, and team spaces. Titles include Overwatch, League of Legends, Rocket League, FIFA, NBA2K, Valorant, and more.

St. Ambrose University Esports

SAU competes in games like Overwatch, Rocket League, Call of Duty, and Super Smash Bros. Their 960 sq. ft. arena features 28 Alienware PCs, streaming gear, and VOD review tech. SAU offers a near-professional experience with travel, scholarships, and career prep.



Pickleball is booming in the Quad Cities, just as it is nationwide. With a growing local club of over 500 members and expanding court access, the region is primed for major tournaments and year-round play. Highlights include the newly added eight lighted outdoor courts at Riverside Park in Moline and the Quad City Tennis Club, which hosted over 400 players during the Quad Cities Pickleball Classic. As court capacity continues to grow, so does the region's reputation as a premier destination for regional and national pickleball events.

ROAD, RACE & TRAIL

East Moline BMX Speedway

A national-level, outdoor BMX Track that was rebuilt by an Olympic Track Builder in 2015. This facility features over 1,500 parking spaces, outdoor lighting, a pro-gate start system, an announcer's tower, high definition cameras, and a mobile moto server, as well as a built-in concession stand.

Events Hosted: USA BMX National Series Event, Gold Cup Qualifiers, North-Central Gold Cup Championships, National Series Events, USA BMX Iowa Indoor State Championships.

Mississippi Valley Fairgrounds

Multi-use facility and grounds in Davenport that include a 1/2-mile track. Bleacher seating for 5,500, lighting, and concessions. Hosts equestrian, demolition derbies, racing, car shows and more.

Events Hosted: Weekly IMCA-sanctioned 1/4 mile track stock car races, Annual World of Outlaw Race, and more.

Cordova International Raceway

This lighted, 190-acre facility with a NHRA-sanctioned 1/4 mile track features a 300 ft. smooth ground concrete launch surface, 1,400 ft. asphalt, 2,000 feet of shutdown down and 500 ft. sand trap. Bleacher seating for 1,000, and concessions.

Events Hosted: World Series of Drag Racing, Nitro Nostalgia Nationals, 2024 BOP Nationals, National Street Rod Association and more.

On and Off Road Competitions

The Quad Cities is the crossroads of the Mississippi River Trail (MRT), the American Discovery Trail (ADT), gravel road cycling, and the new national Rails to Trails, which follows former rail lines to connect communities across the country. This is a cycling and running community with over 100 miles of biking and hiking trails. From challenging mountain biking courses and paved cycling trails to road races and triathlons, the region attracts competitors from across the United States for a variety of on and off-road sporting events.

Scott County Park spans 1,280 acres and offers hiking trails, cross-country skiing, and camping opportunities. Loud Thunder Forest Preserve features 1,480 acres of natural beauty, including a 167-acre lake, along with hiking, equestrian and cross-country ski trails, and camping. Illiniwek Forest Preserve covers 174 acres and is known for its scenic hiking and mountain biking trails, as well as camping along the Mississippi River.
